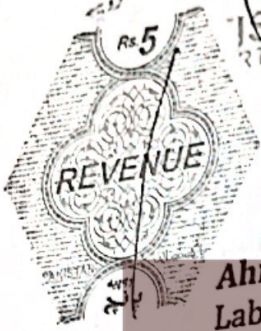

SUMMARY OF THE PETITION

The Petitioner is aggrieved of the Advertisement published by PARC on May 9, 2024, whereby the recruitment process for the appointments of Senior Scientific Officers and Principle Scientific Officers on regular basis has been initiated. This process is illegal, biased, malicious, and lacks jurisdiction, due to: (i) The involvement of the Respondents No. 6 to 10 claiming to be the "Whole-Time Members" without legal backing, as their appointments have not been made by the President of Pakistan as required by Section 10 of the PARC Ordinance, 1981 and they are not tenured; (ii) The appointment of the Respondents No. 6 to 10 by the Chairman, PARC who lacks jurisdiction to make such appointments under the PARC Ordinance, 1981; (iii) The "Whole time Members" should have been appointed on a tenured basis in MP Scale under the PARC Special Pay Scales Packages approved by the Prime Minister in 2007; (iv) Absence of "Whole time Members" in the Selection Committee as Chair and Members, violating PARC Policy and Administrative Directives; (v) A tailored recruitment criteria that deviates from the Recruitment Criteria-2017 duly approved by the PARC

Through this application the applicant is seeking an injunctive order against recruitments being made by the respondents.

2. The learned counsel for the applicant states that the subject-matter of the instant petition overlaps with subject-matter of Writ Petition No.3504 of 2024, in which this Court has passed an injunctive order directing the respondents to stay their hands and not

undertake recruitment process pursuant to the advertisements impugned in the said petition.

He states that in the instant petition as well the advertisements issued by the respondents have been impugned and the grounds for challenge of this are also the same, including, *inter alia*, that the Board of PARC is not duly constituted by whole-time members appointed
